We remain committed to creative worship, deepening prayer, accessible teaching, serving locally and globally, taking calculated risks and being a church that values creativity, fun and laughter. As ever we continue to be passionate about giving those who are not yet Christians the space and opportunity to explore the Christian faith.

Ps & Gs vision

Even in the midst of change, we are still passionate about our vision. It remains the same:

God is calling us to be a church that makes whole-life disciples, sharing the whole of the gospel, with the whole of society, through churches of grace.

TWO-YEAR PLAN

From autumn 2022 until the end of 2024, we will focus on several priority areas. We will also carry out a major strategic review over that time and this will lead to the development of a longer-term, comprehensive strategy, to be launched in 2025.

In the meantime, we will focus on the following priority areas for the next two years. We will:

Grow and deepen

- Continue to invest in building the church community and our relationships through Sunday gatherings, social events,
 Connect groups, teaching, hospitality and serving together
- Help one another to grow as confident and resilient disciples, and people who share their faith, through our Sunday services, courses, prayer, mentoring and Connect groups, and by training leaders
- Deepen strategic partnerships with local organisations such as Bethany Christian Trust and Ferrywell Youth Project
- Continue to develop our key ministry areas, namely Children's and Youth ministry, Students, Caring for Creation and Saturday Meal
- Continue to look outward and support wider ministry through the Micah Fund and our Global Focus Mission Partners
- Develop and expand our existing wholeness ministries including the Ps & Gs Counselling Service, pastoral care and courses

Explore and plan

- Build a healthy and responsive church planting plan with the Scottish Episcopal Church and other denominations and networks
- Appoint a second curate with a view to them developing a Ps & Gs church plant
- Continue to explore and develop our online ministry
- Appoint a staff position to lead our long-term response to local and national need, and develop our plans for social transformation
